DALLASTOWN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE ANNOUNCES: SWIMMING & DIVING SCHOLARSHIP

(Dallastown, PA)—At its November 17, 2016 meeting, the Dallastown Foundation Scholarship Committee unanimously approved the establishment of an endowed Swimming and Diving Scholarship.

The Scholarship was a vision of Coach Rich Howley, who has led the Wildcats Swimming and Diving Programs for approximately 30 years. He believes that the Scholarship will be a great way to recognize and to reward the academic and athletic success and leadership of seniors who participate in the Swimming Program. He thought that the many alumni of the successful Swimming and Diving Program would be inclined to support it.

At a minimum, the goal is to award two (2) Five Hundred Dollar (\$500) Scholarships per year, with one (1) to a girl swimmer and one (1) to a boy swimmer. They will have demonstrated strong academic performance, school, community & charitable involvement, skill enrichment and work experience in accordance with the objective criteria of the Committee. Additionally, the recipients shall have been members in good standing of the swimming and diving team for at least three (3) years, including his and her senior years. There may be additional opportunities/criteria based upon future contributions.

The Dallastown High School Swimming and Diving Booster Club has established this Scholarship, in conjunction with Coach Howley. The Scholarship is open to additional donations from alumni, supporters and friends of Dallastown Swimming and Diving.
